- Complete review of Appendix B including FDA form 2399 (raw milk sampler evaluation report)



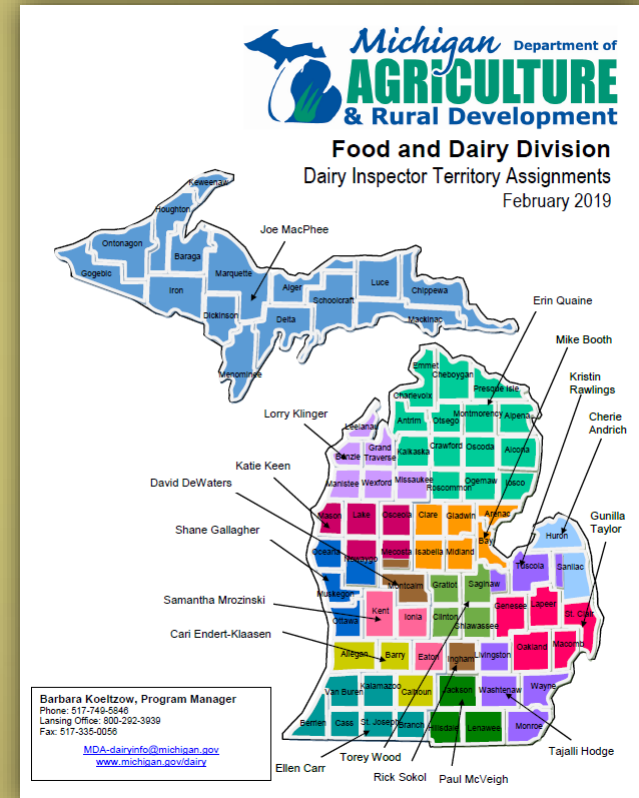

MiDIS

- Temporary fix to the former Dairy Farm Inspection System (DFIS)
- Will generate time savings for dairy inspectors and management
- Ability to write and print inspection reports via tablet at the dairy farm
- Temporary solution until a vendor can be identified with capability to create a viable web based solution

- 66 Manufacturing grade dairy plants

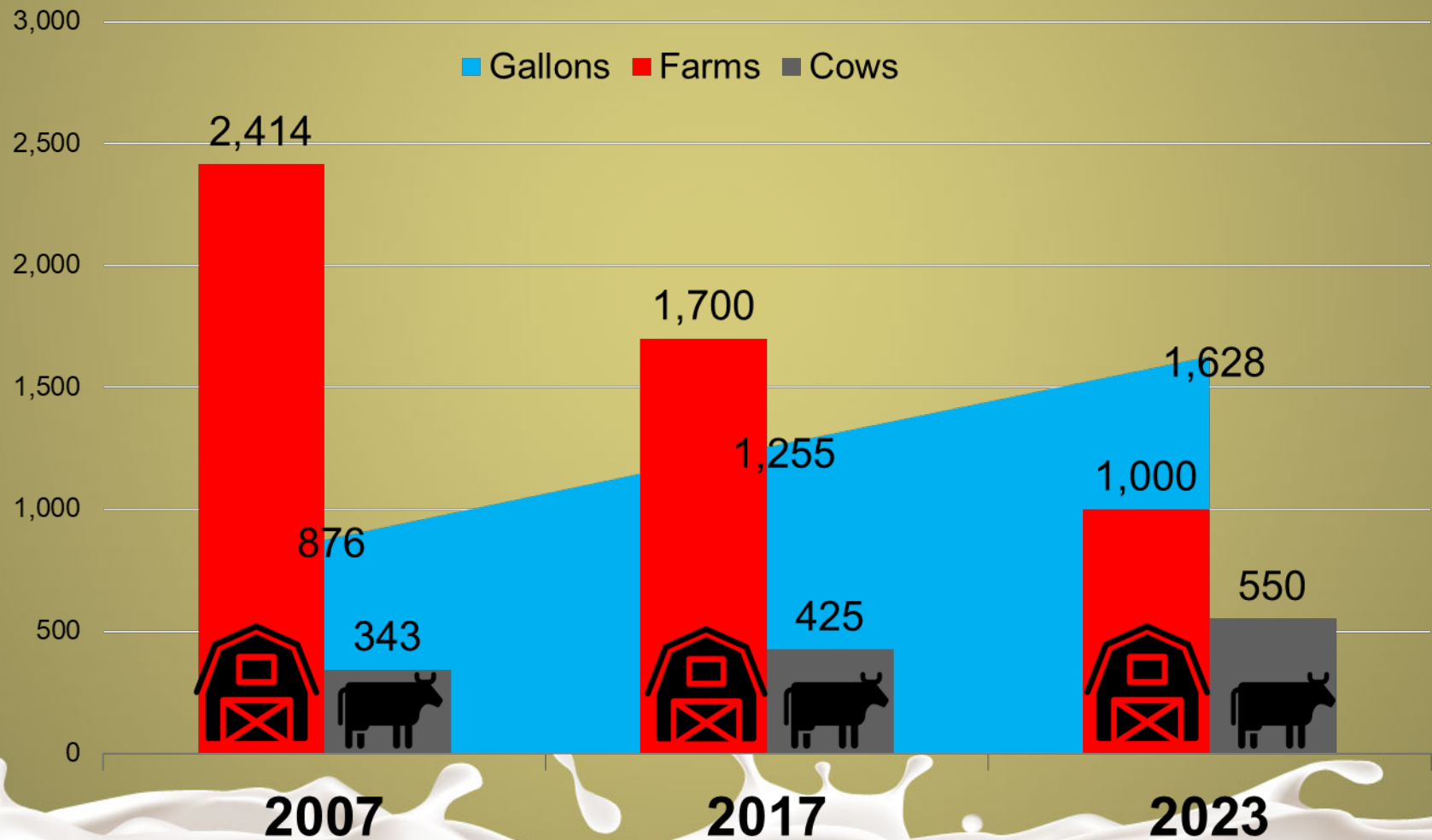


Michigan's Dairy Industry at a Glance
