- Worker Fatal Injuries
 - From 2003 to 2014, 1,435 workers lost their lives at road construction sites
 - Average number of worksite deaths is 115 annually
 - It could be Nate

- 6 confined space
- 3 near tractor trailers
- 3 in moving machinery
- 2 farm animal related
- 2 falls on farms

Why Do "Accidents" Happen?

- Distraction
- Attention to Detail
- Lack of Focus on Task
- Risk Recognition
- Complacency

What Else is Common?

- These are ALL Preventable!
 - Well defined OSHA rules in place to protect
 - LOTO or CoHE
 - Confined Space Entry Procedure
 - Fall Protection
 - Training is important
 - Basic understanding can go a long way
 - Risk assessment process
 - Condition versus Behavior mindset!
 - LEAD with Safety
